FTW Broadlaw Innes, “Daz” was the personal shooting and trial dog of Wildrose UK partner, Vic Barlow. Vic is a frequent guest at Wildrose and is a columnist for the Retriever Journal. He is also the author of British Training for the American Retriever in which Daz is pictured throughout.

Daz was made up as a FTW in 2005. He had previously won the United Retriever Club’s Memorial Trophy at the young age of two years. He has retrieved, or as the Brits say, “picked up” literally thousands of birds at trials and estate shoots across England and Scotland.

Daz has a brilliant pedigree of proven retrievers; FTCh to FTCh bred, and grandsired by International FTCh Theoweir Turramurra Teal, referred to in a 1996 article as “the best natural gamefinder in the UK.” My famous old Drummer, the best upland dog I have ever seen, was double bred Teal. Daz has pups on the ground in the UK at present, which are proving to be easily trained, possessing natural abilities.



In the states, Daz has proven to be an extremely bold, stylish retriever in addition to being a beautiful stamp of a dog. He has pounded through January icy waters for Mississippi ducks and performed like an old hand in muddy fields working from a dog hide retrieving geese. This is a highly intelligent, a very strong, fast, fearless dog in the field with a fantastic nose for game. He also possesses a most pleasing personality (he has never met a stranger), is calm in the blind and easy to handle. Daz is a premier English retriever whose pups will complement the lifestyle of the most discriminating of wingshooters.
